

# Year 3 Autumn One Curriculum Map



#### Maths

We will be building on our place value knowledge, including representing and partitioning numbers up to 1,000. We will learn to become fluent and efficient in addition and subtraction, including the use of formal written methods and mental methods.

Vocabulary: comparing, ordering, accuracy, addition, subtraction, integer, representation, partition, estimation, sum, addend, subtrahend.

### Writing

We will be learning to structure and write a persuasive letter, a character description, a narrative, a poem based on Space Week and a diary entry. Our writing will be based around the poem Billy and the Minpins by Roald Dahl and Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura.

Vocabulary: stanza, poem, rhyme, fronted adverbial, noun phrase, prepositional phrase, emotive language, rhetorical question, first person, repetition

## Reading

We will be learning to develop our reading skills across different text types, including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. We will develop our oracy skills through classroom based discussion. We will build on and develop our inference, retrieval, prediction, language understanding and summarising skills.

**Vocabulary:** retrieval, inference, predict, summarise, decoding, fluency, structure, root word, prefix, suffix.

### Science Rocks and Soils

We will be learning about the 3 different types of rock: igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic, plus human made rocks. In addition, we will learn about soils and what it is made up of.

We will also explore Space as part of Space Week 2024.

Vocabulary: fossil, fossilisation, sedimentary, igneous, metamorphic, sediment, permeable, impermeable, durable, minerals, texture

# History

The Stone Age: What Was New About The Stone Age?
We will be learning about the Stone Age, the period of history
before written records began. We will be examining some of
the greatest achievements of these people, such as
Stonehenge and Skara Brae.

**Vocabulary:** prehistory, archaeology, quarry, flint, hunter gatherer, forage, settlement, microlith, monument, nomadic, artefact

# Art & DT Eating Seasonally

We will be learning that fruits and vegetables grow in different countries base on their climates. We will understand that seasonal foods grow in a given season. We will design a tart using seasonal ingredients.

Vocabulary: fruit, vegetable, import, export, climate, country, ingredients, taste, seasonal, tropical, temperate, seasons, weather

### RE

Pilgrimage To The River Ganges

We will be learning about Sanatani beliefs about the River Ganges and some of the practices which occur there.

Sanatanis believe that any <u>rituals</u> performed on the banks of the Ganges or in its water will wash away impurity.

**Vocabulary:** flood plain, fertile, pilgrimage, pollutant, source, nutrients, ashes, cremation, deity, rituals

## Being Me in my World

We will be learning what makes a good citizen and understanding how our actions affect other people locally and globally.

Vocabulary: goals, worries, fears, rights, community, empathy, choices, responsibilities, consequences, learning charter, legal, illegal, laws, democracy.

## Pronunciation: Colours and Numbers

We will be learning pronunciation this half term, looking at the 26 different phonemes that are used in spoken French but are not used in English. By focusing on these sounds, we will be able to improve the quality of our pronunciation and we will also become more confident in reading unknown words.

# Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA) & Netball

In OAA, we will be learning to improve on our teamwork, coordination and orienteering skills. In netball, we will be learning to develop our accuracy of aiming at a target. We will develop our understanding of different passing techniques.

Vocabulary: compass, orienteering, balance, collaboration, teamwork, passing, shooting.

# E-Safety - Be Internet Legends

We will be learning the skills we need to stay safe and confident online. We will learn about the pillars of internet safety, including privacy, respect, information sharing and understanding if information is real.

**Vocabulary:** share, password, phishing, messages, data, information, privacy, safety.
